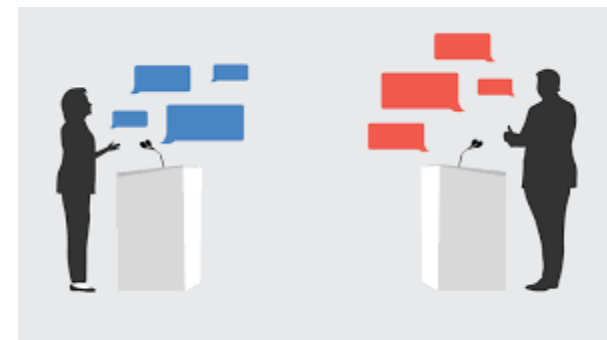

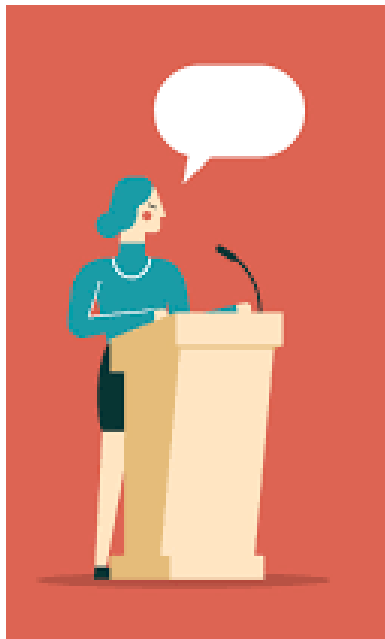
## 14. Ad mad
