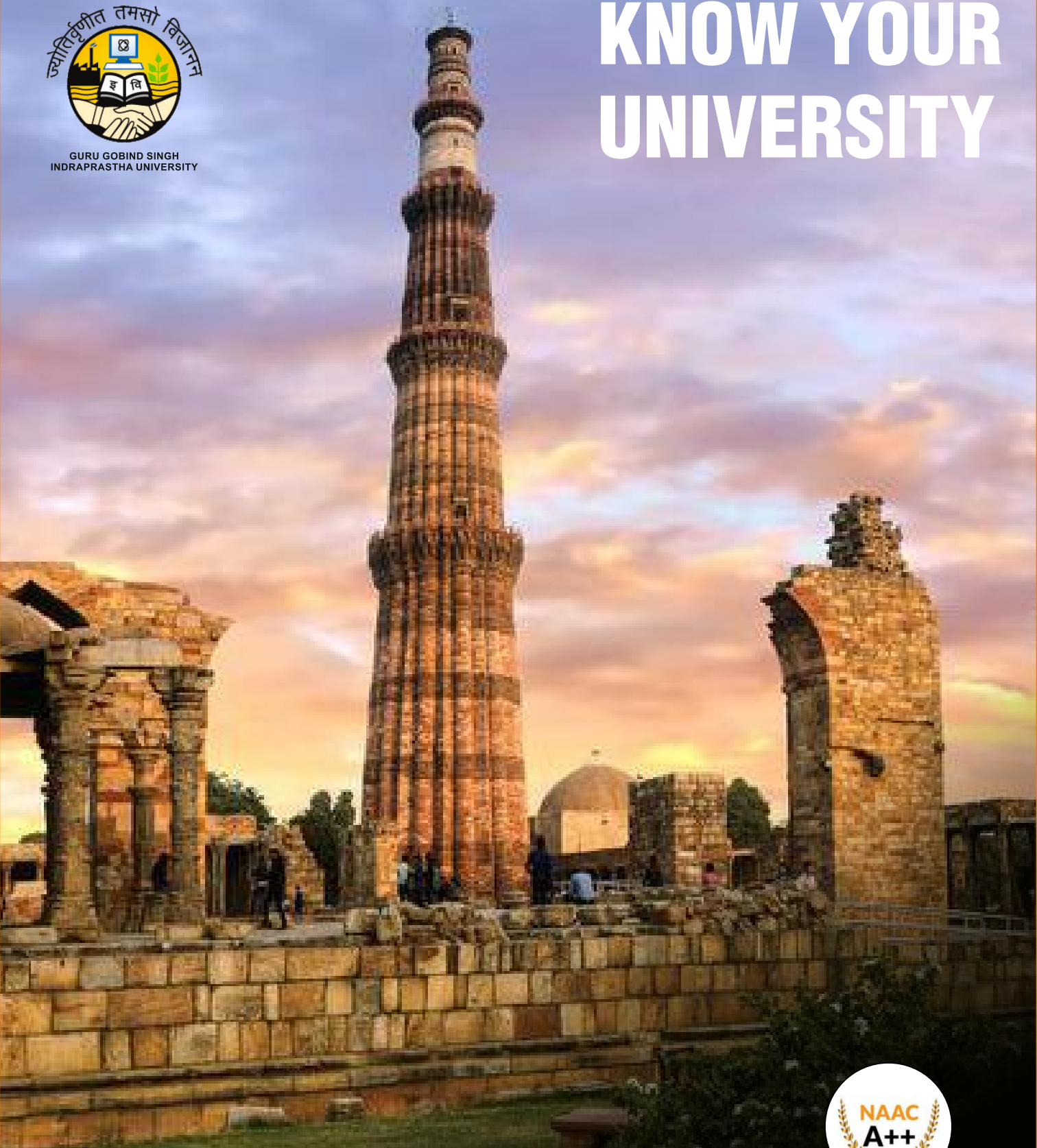

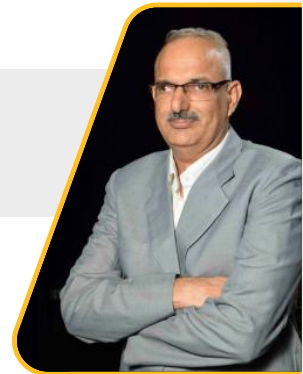

# RECENT ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

## OVERVIEW

DME Media School facilitates industry training of students during summer internships & also organizes interactions by inviting eminent people from the industry. This training conducted through various interactions such as conferences, webinars etc., helps students in acquiring necessary practical skills and prepares them for the industry.

## INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES

International Conference on Artificial Intelligence: Its Uses and Ethics in Media Organized by DME Media School

DME Media School successfully hosted the seventh edition of the International Conference - ICAN-7, drawing a diverse and dynamic mix of academicians, industry experts, researchers, and students from across India and abroad.

With the theme "Artificial Intelligence: Its Uses and Ethics in Media", ICAN-7 served as a forward-thinking academic platform exploring how AI is revolutionizing journalism, media content, audience behaviour, and communication ethics.

The conference featured multiple plenary sessions, led by renowned experts and thought leaders in the fields of media, AI, law, and ethics. These sessions addressed critical topics such as AI's influence on newsroom practices, the ethics of algorithmic decision-making, challenges of deepfakes, and the implications of automated journalism.

Technical sessions witnessed the presentation of peer-reviewed research papers from scholars and emerging academics. Topics covered a wide range - AI in content recommendation systems, media regulation, digital surveillance, and inclusive technology practices. These sessions encouraged rigorous academic exchange and critical reflection.

Complementing the academic sessions were interactive workshops focused on practical and skill-based learning. Workshops on AI tools for journalists, data storytelling, and ethical AI design helped participants bridge theory with hands-on application.

ICAN-7 also facilitated student-centric discussions, where young scholars shared their ideas and perspectives, reinforcing the conference's commitment to nurturing the next generation of responsible media professionals.

By combining critical scholarship, interdisciplinary exchange, and experiential learning, ICAN-7 highlighted the urgent need for ethically grounded innovation in AI-driven media.

With its rich engagement and meaningful outcomes, ICAN-7 reaffirmed DME Media School's role as a hub of progressive media education and global academic dialogue.



## OTHER EVENTS

**CIFFI:** CIFFI Cineaste International Film Festival of India - CIFFI: This festival is the only film festival in the world organized by two educational institutions of two countries located in different continents. DME organizes this festival in association with Deakin University, Melbourne. The first edition of CIFFI was organized on April 17-20, 2019. This 4-day festival comprised 81 screenings, 4 curate sessions, 3 workshops and 2 master classes. Filmmakers and film experts from 12 countries participated in this festival. The second edition of CIFFI organized on December 15-21, 2020 became the World's First 7- Day Hybrid International Film Festival by educational institutes. The highlights included 110 films from 10 countries, 10 Indian States and 10 languages in 7 categories with 21 sessions. CIFFI 2021 with the tagline of Cinematic Rejuvenation held again on December 15-21 further experimented with hybrid mode. This third edition reached the next level with 3130 films in 40 languages (10 Indian languages) from 111 countries. A total of 438 films were screened in the film with a runtime of 438 hours. This festival was supported by 17 partners. CIFFI 2022 with the tagline of Cinema for Togetherness was conducted on the same dates of December (from 15th to 21st). This time, University of Nottingham, China campus also joined hands along with Deakin University, Melbourne. While Tigmanshu Dhulia continued to be the Festival Ambassador, Vinay Pathak joined as Festival Face and Yashpal Sharma as Festival Personality in the 4th edition of the film festival. As many as 3374 films were received from 112 countries in the competitive and non-competitive categories. The number of partners reached 20. CIFFI 2023 subsequently the fifth edition of CIFFI was hosted by DME and Nottingham university chain was the partner. Mr Vipin Sharma is a renowned film actor. As many as more than one thousand films were received from 113 countries in the competitive and non-competitive categories.

**VRITIKA:** Vritika- Convention of Media Students provides a 3 day platform to media students across the country to deliberate and discuss relevant, contemporary media issues with their peers and experts.

Vritika provides the participants an opportunity to explore their potential through Creative writing, News writing, Debate, Photography, Media Quiz, Anchor Hunt, Radio Jingle, RJ Hunt, Digital Poster Making, Ad Mad, Storytelling, Talent Hunt and many more competitions.

**B G VERGHESE LECTURE SERIES:** Under this series, a special lecture is organized every month with eminent media personalities and experts on issues related to media and other subjects of contemporary value. Since its institution in 2015, a good number of scholars and media practitioners have spoken in this series. These include Mr NK Singh, Mr Prashant Tandon, Mr Prabhat Shunglu, Prof. K G Suresh, Prof. Ujjwal K Chowdhury, Mr Paranjay Guha Thakurta, Mr Rajesh Badal, Mr Harvir Singh, Mr Subhomoy Bhattacharjee, Mr Aman Hingorani and Ms Archana Datta, Rohit Ranjan, Aman Chopra and Shshir Sinha. Since 2021, many foreign scholars have delivered special lectures under this B G Verghese Lecture Series including Dr Eylem Atakav (UK), Dr Ali Reza Bastani (Iran) and Dr Andrew Otis (US).



# DME TV

DME operates its YouTube channel DME TV to provide its students a platform to hone their reporting, anchoring and production skills and prepare them thoroughly for the industry by engaging in constructive learning and getting acquainted with the professional environment.

DME TV has its own production facility and has a number of active programmes in its basket like DME UNO, a daily dose of contemporary information; DME Sport, the sport bulletin of DME; DME Round Up, campus news programme; DME Dialogue, an interview based programme; DME Students Corner, interview platform of eminent guests by students; DME Flashlight, featuring community connect initiatives and many more.

Special lectures, workshops or seminars conducted by leading personalities from academics and industry are captured in DME Discourse, again a student's produced programme.



# MEDIA RESEARCH

The Research Cell at DME Media School is a vibrant hub committed to fostering academic excellence and a strong research culture among students and faculty. It encourages critical inquiry, interdisciplinary exploration, and ethical scholarship in media and communication studies. The Cell organizes international conferences like ICAN, student research conclaves, seminars, workshops, and weekly research forums. - Diwali donations and fun activities at local villages and orphanages

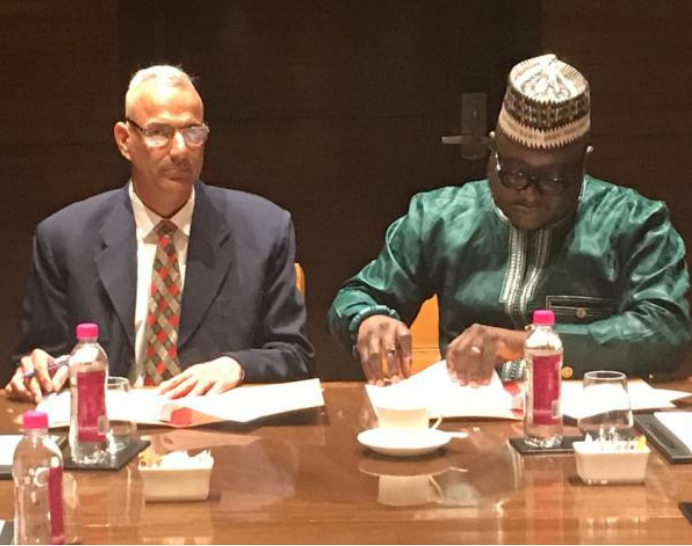


# Mentoring @DME
