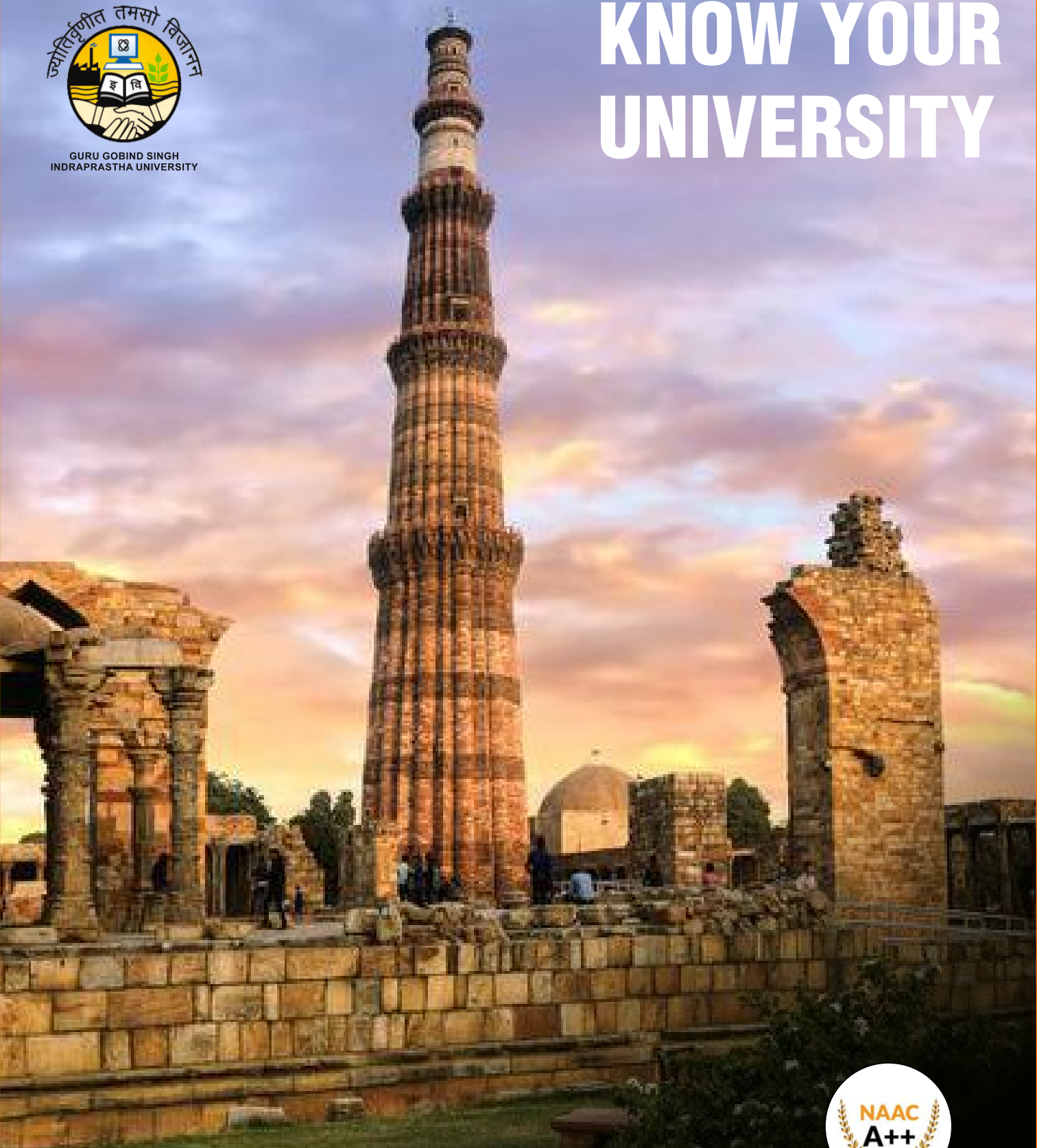

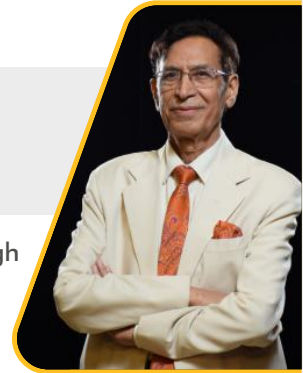

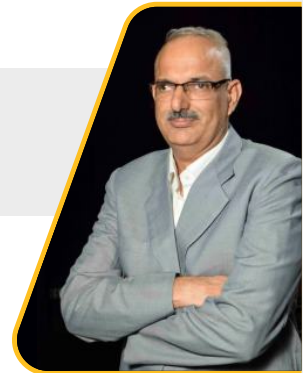

With the introduction of 3 years of mandatory practice at bar as the eligibility criteria for the Judicial Service exams, DME also offers a robust LLM program (pursuing of which is considered as practice at bar as per the 3-year eligibility criteria), along with the preparation at JTA. Along with LLM JTA can be studied without losing on 3 years practice criteria.
