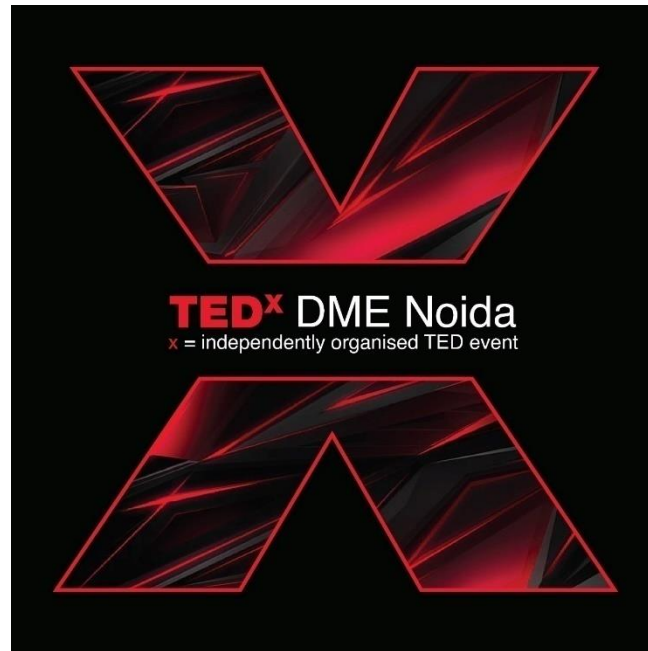

The highly oxygenated Areca leaves allows fruits and raw vegetables to remain fresh for a long time, perfect for use in fast-food centres, hotels & restaurants, parties, and weddings.



An entrepreneur and co-founder of the Prakriti Foundation, whose vision is to be an eco-warrior, began his talk by citing the popular 90s programme Shaktiman as his inspiration for the topic of lessening plastic use. He has also given 5000+ compostable sanitary pads to deprived women and donated 1500+ books to underprivileged children. Awardee of National Water Hero Award in the month of June, by Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India. Started his green journey at the age of 8.



A 14-year-old student activist and co-founder of the organization “We Rise Together.” He started the organization when he was eight years old. We can rightly say that he is a real game changer as he has planted more than 5000 trees, provided low-income women with sanitary pads, and donated books and spread awareness. He concluded with a very empowering thought by stating that we all have the power to change the world all that is required is to utilize power in the right direction.

**v. Prerna Prasad**

**Talk Title: An Era of Sustainable Tourism**

After working for more than 8 years in prominent English news channels like CNN-IBN & India Today, Prerna chose the path of entrepreneurship. Combining her love for travel and vision to create an environmental impact, she started Ecoplore. She spent the first 2 years in ground research by visiting different eco-friendly hotels and understanding the real meaning of sustainable tourism. She aims to invest all her income generated from Ecoplore in developing a forest and returning it back to nature.



Ms. Prerna Prasad, the founder of Ecoplore talked about reducing the carbon emissions, putting emphasis on the statement, “Tourism adds 8% carbon to the world.” She started her career as a journalist, then became an activist, moved into politics, and now is an entrepreneur. She traveled to a location in Tamil Nadu and spent a month searching for five eco-friendly hotels. Her research revealed that eco hotels produce 9 kg of carbon dioxide per night, while luxury hotels produce 1000 kg of carbon dioxide per night and average hotels produce 75 kg of carbon dioxide per night. Her aim was to spread awareness amongst the travelers.

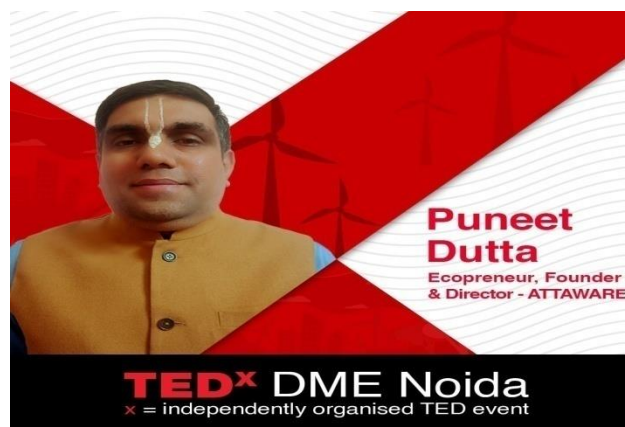

TerreGeneration's clients work directly with over 50 million people, in major Indian cities and over 50,000 villages spread across more than half the districts in India. This includes over 700,000 farmers, and Commons of over 11.5 million acres. The team's work gained attention initially by making clean-ups, tree-planting drives fun, "fashionable" and scalable using content and PR.



Mr Jacob Cherian began his talk by sharing Benjamin's quote, "I have not failed; I just found 100 ways to be wrong." He emphasizes that every step counts that is taken towards making our environment a better place. Even if each one of us takes only one step, it shall make a huge difference. He also said our daily lives should be carved in a manner that generates positive impact on our climate.

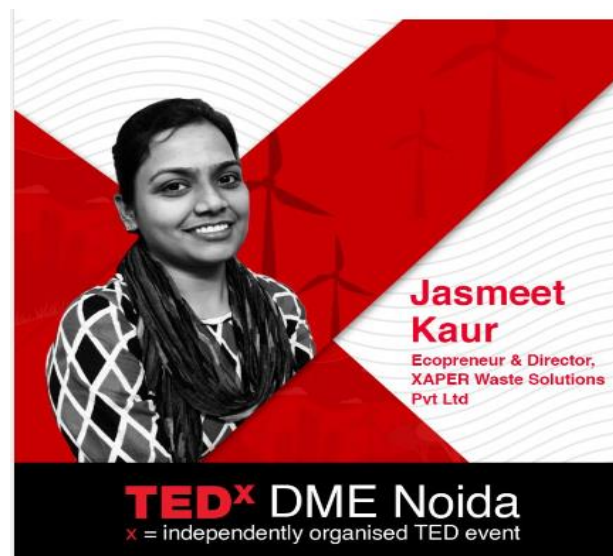
